The Republic of Lebanon represented by the Presidency of the Council of Ministers will receive a Grant from *the International Canadian Development Agency (CIDA)* toward the cost of the Second Emergency Social Protection Implementation Support Project – ESPISP II, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this grant for *the NPTP in Lebanon* to eligible payments under the contract: for *the Provision and Installation of Servers & PCs*.

The Fiduciary Operations Team (FOT) now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the Provision & Installation of Servers & PCs in Lebanon for the NPTP - Ministry of Social Affairs, in several Social Centers in Lebanon. The maximum duration for the supply, install and commissioning of Goods is sixty (60) days following the signature of the Contracts.

Bidding will be conducted through the national competitive bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's *Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits* published in May 2004 and revised in October 2006 and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the guidelines.

Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information and inspect the bidding documents from The Fiduciary Operations Team (FOT) at the address below during office hours *i.e. 09:00 to 16:00 hours*.

A complete set of bidding documents in English may be delivered to any interested eligible bidder for free.

All bids must be accompanied by a bid security of ten thousand (10,000) US or an equivalent amount in any other foreign currency and valid for 120 days after the bid submission deadline and be delivered to the address below by **12h noon on March 3, 2011**.

Bids will be opened immediately thereafter, in the presence of bidders' representatives, who choose to attend, at the address below. Late bids will be rejected.
